



How do we receive the Global Leadership Summit (GLS)?

The GLS is streamed over the internet. We use a purpose-built platform to provide a high-quality stream, made available to all our sites via a web URL. We provide all the necessary training videos, looping & live test content throughout the summer to get you ready for the GLS.

How do we make sure our site can stream the GLS?

Test Your Bandwidth

Run a bandwidth test: <https://www.speakeasy.net/speedtest/>

We recommend a minimum download speed of 15 Mbps.

We recommend a dedicated, hardwired connection for the streaming computer as opposed to using WiFi as your primary connection to the internet.

Make sure your computer meets the minimum recommended specifications.

Windows 11 or macOS 11

Latest Version of Chrome or Firefox Browser (Edge, Safari, & others don't work well with our streaming platform)

8Gb RAM

What should we use to present the GLS at our site?

The GLS takes place over 2 days, featuring around 8 hours of content per day. When preparing for the GLS, consider both the expected number of guests and the size of the room. To ensure an optimal viewing experience for your guests, ask yourself: what setup will work best? Here are the suggested minimum specifications.

Projector: A 6,000-7,000 lumens projector that is native HD (laser or DLP).

Screen: 16:9 widescreen with a trim kit (front or rear projection)

Screen Size: 9ft x 16ft minimum size

Location: One screen, center of viewing area.
